In response to an enquiry on the outcome of the Library Service consultation, it was confirmed that a decision had not yet been taken by DCC at this time.

55. TO RESOLVE THAT THE MINUTES OF THE CEMETERY, PARKS & HIGHWAY MATTERS COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 2 OCTOBER 2018 ARE A CORRECT RECORD

RESOLVED: that the Minutes of the meeting held on 2 October 2018, copies of which have been previously circulated to Members, were confirmed as a true record.

56. MATTERS FOR REPORT

- I. Page 10 – Item 46 Doncaster Avenue Recreation Ground (DARG): Litter bin
The newly sited litter bin positioned by the library car park and Parish Council office had been reinstated following an incident of vandalism when first installed.
- II. Page 10 – Item 48.1 DARG: EBC play inspection reports
EBC had confirmed that duplicated play area inspections would be cancelled. The Parish Council had been thanked for bringing the matter to their attention.
- III. Page 10 – 48.2 DARG: Swing Basket
Following discussion, Wicksteed had agreed to replace a set of chains for the Basket Swing and the item would shortly be reinstated.

57. PARISH COUNCIL CEMETERY

- I. Burials and interments
Burial Area 2, Row B, G3 10/10/18
- II. Reserved plots since the last meeting
None.
- III. To note 2 graves without a current owner
It was noted that a transfer of rights had not taken place for grave 172 and 190.

The circumstances had been unavoidable and no-one had come forward to take ownership. ICCM had confirmed that future responsibility for the graves and memorials lay with the Parish Council. Office records had been noted accordingly.

RESOLVED: that the Parish Council accept responsibility for the two graves unless circumstances changed and a Transfer of Rights was issued

58. PARISH COUNCIL PARKS (Doncaster Avenue Recreation Ground/Springfield Park)

- I. Springfield Park – Damaged dog waste bin
It was noted that Horizon Landscapes had offered to replace a dog waste bin that had been damaged on the park during the last round of grass cutting.

RESOLVED: to accept the offer of a replacement dog waste bin

- II. Electrical matters
The Clerk had met with an electrician to evaluate a number of lamp columns that remained unlit and were maintained by the Parish Council. A quote was awaited.

RESOLVED: that the Clerk, in consultation with the Chairman and Vice-Chairman consider the quotation in order to move the matter forward between meetings
