## Notes and definitions

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<sup>1</sup> Your spouse, civil partner or a person with whom you are living as spouse or civil partner is referred to as 'another relevant person'.

<sup>2</sup> This is defined in section 32(1)(b) of the Localism Act 2011 as an interest where the disclosure could lead to you or a person connected with you being subject to violence or intimidation.

<sup>3</sup> Any payment or other financial provision made within the last 12 months in respect of any expenses you have incurred in carrying out your duties as a councillor or towards your election expenses.

<sup>4</sup> Any contract between you (or another relevant person) and the Parish Council where goods/services are to be provided or works are to be carried out **and** which has not been fully discharged – this includes a body in which either of you has a beneficial interest.

<sup>5</sup> Any land or property which you or another relevant person own, lease, rent or have any beneficial interest in within the area of the Parish Council.

<sup>6</sup> Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the Parish Council for a month or longer.

<sup>7</sup> Any tenancy where (to your knowledge) the landlord is the Parish Council **and** the tenant is a body in which you or another relevant person has a beneficial interest.

<sup>8</sup> Where that body has a place of business or land within the area of the Parish Council **AND** either

- i. the total nominal value exceeds £25,000 or 1/100<sup>th</sup> of total issued shares, or
- ii 1/100<sup>th</sup> of the nominal value of shares of any one class.

Securities are defined as shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000. Does **NOT** include money deposited with a building society.

<sup>9</sup> Where you are a member or hold a position of general control or management and to which you were appointed or nominated by the Parish Council.

<sup>10</sup> A body exercising functions of a public nature and where you are a member or hold a position of general control or management.

<sup>11</sup> A body directed to charitable purposes and where you are a member or hold a position of general control or management.

<sup>12</sup> Including any political party or trade union.
