Towards a Minerals Local Plan – Spring 2018 Consultation

Derbyshire County and Derby City Councils are consulting on the next stage of the Minerals Local Plan preparation.

Previous stages have included the following consultations Issues and Options 2010, Sand and Gravel Strategy and sites 2012, Rolling Consultation 2015/2016 (Vision, Objectives, and Strategies for all minerals) and Hard Rock Methodology and Sites 2016/2017.

Comments received at these stages have been used by the Councils to develop the Spring 2018 Consultation which contains:

- A draft Vision, Objectives and Strategic Sustainability Principles;
- A draft Strategy for each of the important minerals within the Plan area to ensure their supply throughout the Plan period to 2030;
- A set of draft policies which will be used to assess and determine planning applications for mineral development;
- The draft allocation (identification) of specific sites for working sand and gravel, industrial limestone and brick clay.

We are now inviting comments on this document for a period of eight weeks. All comments should be received by Friday 18 May 2018.
