

**DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

FOOTPATH CLOSURE
PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO.19 (PART)
SANDIACRE PARISH**

WHEN: 25th June 2018 – 6th July 2018

WHERE: Close Public Footpath No. 19 (Part) Sandiacre Parish from its junction with the south end of Canal Street for a distance of approximately 280 metres northwards. Also close access track 24 metres from its junction with Brookfield Mews for a distance of approximately 80 metres south-eastwards where Nottingham County Council's closure comes into effect.

REASON: To facilitate works to repair the flood defence asset.

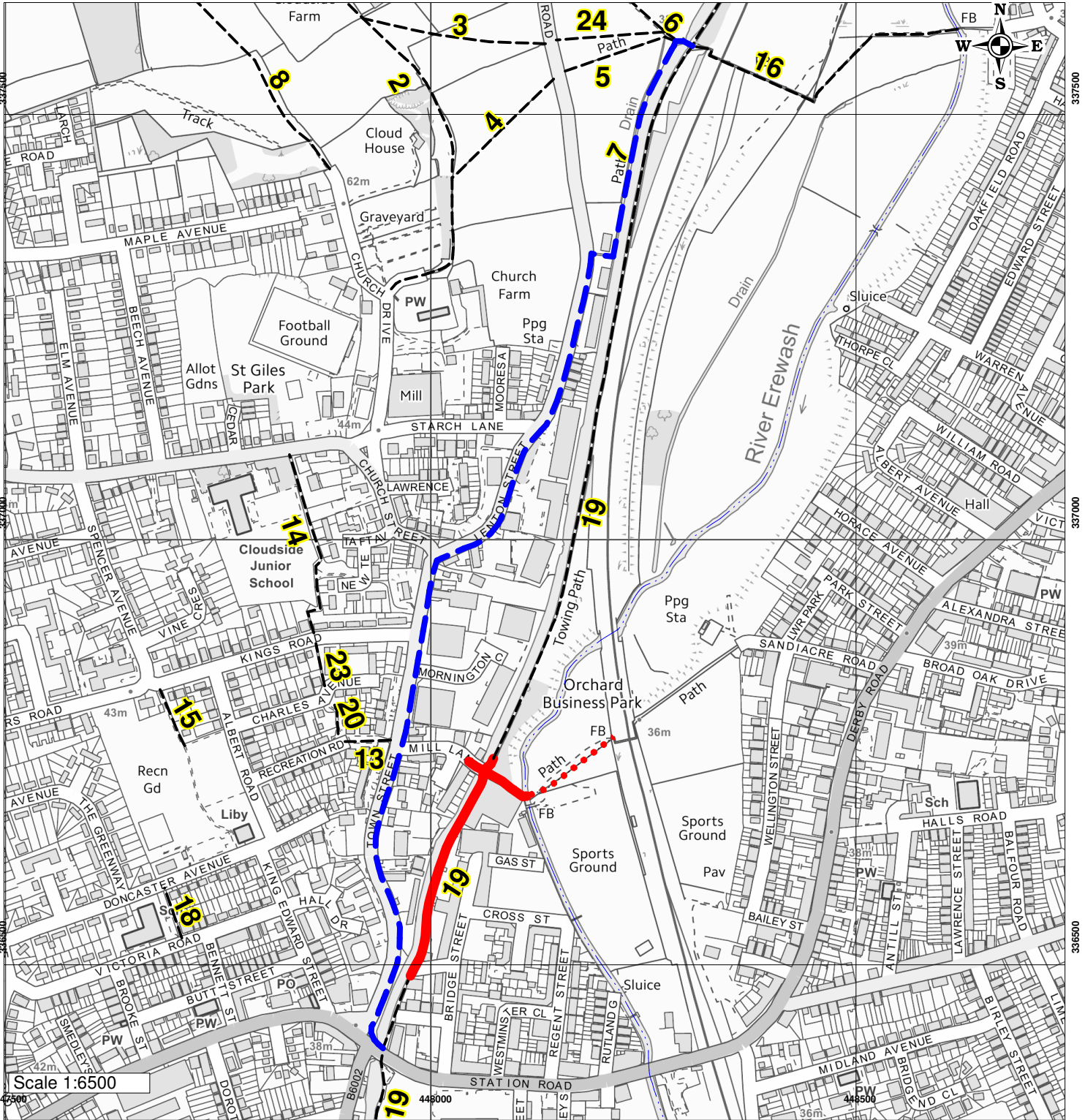
ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: FOR PEDESTRAINS ONLY. From the south-west: Station Road - Town Street - Lenton Street - Public Footpath No. 7 - Public Footpath No. 16. Vice versa from the north-east. ACCESS CANNOT BE REGAINED TO PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 19 (CANAL TOWPATH) FROM ANY OTHER PLACES.

Access will be maintained, whenever reasonably possible, on the affected length of footpath. The footpath will re-open as soon as the work is finished. This may be earlier than advertised.

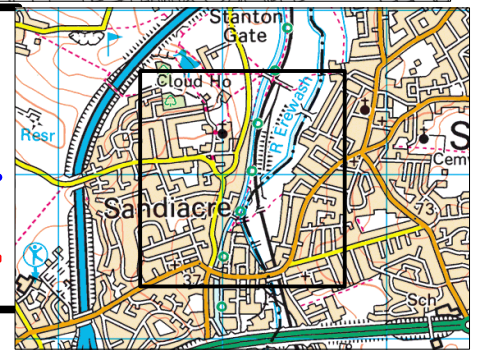
ALTERNATIVE ROUTE
