**Non Resident Charges**

*A resident is classed as someone whose main residence is within the Parish Council's boundaries at the time of death or on the electoral role at the time of their death.*

*A non-resident is classed as someone whose main residence is not within the Parish Council's boundaries at their time of death or is not on the electoral role at the time of their death.*

*People who have lived more than 10 years within the Parish Council's boundaries and then move directly to a care home, hospice or hospital outside of the Parish Council's boundaries for a period of not greater than 5 years upon their death will be classed as residents. Proof of residency will be required.*

**Grave Digging**

**Sandiacre Parish Council does not make provision for the digging of graves or plots and this responsibility lies with the Funeral Directors. Therefore, the fees listed above do not include any charges for this work.**
