



Update: COVID-19 Food Project Funding Opportunities

We at Feeding Derbyshire, hope that you're keeping well and staying safe during these very unusual and worrying times.

We wanted to bring to your attention some additional funding opportunities that we have just been made aware of. The deadlines for some of these are extremely tight so will require a quick turn around on your part if you wish to apply. Not all of them may be suitable for your project, but please do share with other organisations that you think might benefit.

We are aware that not all food projects have charitable status and that this means not all will be able to apply for certain funding pots. However, we are continuing to look for opportunities and to explore ways of submitting collective proposals.

The Coalfields COVID-19 Recovery

The Coalfields COVID-19 Recovery & Resilience Fund is an interim replacement for the Coalfields Community Investment Programme (CCIP) in order to better support the delivery and sustainability of key services.

Grants of up to £10,000 are still available but committee meetings will be held on a more regular basis (in June and July) to consider applications that can address local needs during this difficult time.

Priority will be given to organisations that are delivering support services or have significantly adapted their services in order to respond to the current crisis and support vulnerable people.

Important application dates:

Mid June 2020 Committee – The deadline for applications is 22nd May, 2020 at 5pm.

Late July 2020 Committee – The Eligibility Survey closes at 5pm on 29th May, 2020. The deadline for applications is 12th June, 2020 at 5pm.

Funding to Support Domestic Abuse Safe Accommodation

Charities providing domestic abuse safe accommodation services have until 21st May, 2020 to submit a bid for a grant of up to £100,000 to support (costs associated with maintaining existing services and additional capacity to meet increase in demand) during the period 1st April to 30th September, 2020.

The deadline for bids is 21st May, 2020.

Barclays' 100x100 COVID-19 Community Relief Programme

Barclays will be making 100 donations of £100,000 each to UK charities working to support vulnerable people impacted by COVID-19, and the associated social and economic hardship caused by the crisis.

Funding will be focused on supporting charity partners who are meeting the immediate needs of people in Barclays communities, including low income families, those facing financial hardship, isolated elderly people and key workers.

Applications will be accepted until 22nd May, 2020 (23:59).

Funding for Homelessness Charities Affected by COVID-19 Crisis

Charitable organisations that are working to keep people who are homeless safe and supported during the COVID-19 pandemic can apply for grants of between £10,000 and £100,000 (depending on the annual turnover of the organisation).

The first deadline for applications is 27th May, 2020.

Government Launches Loneliness COVID-19 Grant Fund

The Department for Digital, Culture, Media & Sport's £5 million Loneliness Covid-19 Grant Fund is providing grants of between £500,000 and £1 million.

The Government will not fund more than 20% of an organisation's turnover through direct grants (and not more than 50% through grants made by umbrella organisations),

Applications will be considered from charities or benevolent and philanthropic organisations providing frontline services.

The deadline for applications is 12pm Friday 29th May, 2020.

Funding for Organisations Supporting Children at Risk of Youth Violence

The Youth Endowment Fund's COVID-19 grant round will fund and evaluate work which supports vulnerable young people at risk of youth violence, and can be delivered whilst adhering to UK government social distancing and stay-at-home guidelines. The minimum grant that organisations can apply for is £25,000.

Deadline - Midday on Wednesday 3rd June 2020
