Covid-19 Rules for this play area

In order to re-open the play area safely, the Parish Council is asking parents, children and visitors to follow some very simple instructions to avoid transmitting the virus:

We ask everyone to be responsible for their own and their children's safety at this time of social distancing.

Please remember to follow the guidance:

- Social distancing: 2 metres or 1 metre with risk mitigations (where 2 metres is not viable) are acceptable
- Play areas to only have 1 family member accompanying a child
- Parents are encouraged to bring hand sanitiser gel or wipes to clean their children's hands
- The consumption of food or drink on play equipment or in the play area is not permitted at this time
- Play area users should dispose of **all litter**. Any used protective wear, such as face coverings or gloves should be taken home
- Parents are reminded that allowing children to use play equipment, seating/picnic tables is done so **AT THEIR OWN RISK**
- Please be courteous and allow everyone to take their turn on play items
- Please follow the current Government guidelines on social distancing when visiting and encourage your children to do the same

We will continue to monitor the situation and if we become concerned about risks within the play areas we will consider the option of closure.
